

Servant-Leaders

Responsible to Camp Director and Summer Program Director

Qualifications:

- 18 to 99 years old.
- Previous counseling experience or experience with age group to be counseled.
- Must have a proven ability and desire to lead, learn, and give as a servant of Jesus Christ, to meet the needs of all campers and staff.
- Must have a written testimony of faith and trust in Jesus Christ alone for eternal life.

Responsibilities:

- Meet with Summer Program Director for specific servant-leader assignments throughout the week.
- Be an example of Christian living as a transparent servant of God, not only with words but also in deed and truth.
- Attend daily prayer and devotion meetings, lifting up yourself, your campers and fellow staff in prayer.
- Work with a cabin group of 6-8 campers, supervise and maintain their safety, enforce all camp rules and regulations, encourage and help them with their memory work, present the Gospel to each one during the week, and help provide an environment suitable for the campers' growth and development.
- Spend time reviewing the curriculum booklet provided by CWR so that you can teach campers from this material.
- Be aware of daily schedules and/or any changes.
- Must develop and maintain proficiency in at least one instructional area. He will normally instruct in one area each day.
- Maintain records on each camper's involvement, participation, and accomplishments throughout his stay at a camp session.
