

# Lifeguard/Water Safety Instructor

Responsible to Camp Director

## **Qualifications:**

- 15 to 99 years old.
- Life guard and CPR certified.
- Enjoys working with youth and adults.
- Written testimony of faith and trust in Jesus Christ alone for eternal life.

## **Pool Responsibilities:**

- Check pool chemicals throughout the day to maintain swimmer safety.
- Confirm that emergency telephone is in place before swimmers arrive. Also make sure the emergency telephone is put away after swimmers leave for the day.
- Pool and water safety for all pool participants.
- Checking each camper's Medical Release Form to determine what each parent has confirmed their child can or cannot accomplish while in the water.
- Instruct all pool participants in the pool rules.
- Confirms there are only 10 people in the pool at a time and 2 are leaders that monitor the activity of the campers.
- Confirms that a break be taken every 30 minutes during each session.
- Determine what each swimmer's competence is before allowing him to participate in pool activities.
- Put away all pool equipment after the last group leaves for the day.

## **Water Front Responsibilities:**

- Teach and confirm that canoe participants are competent to utilize the canoes.
- Administer a brief test in the shallow are of the lake to be certain that canoes are used properly.
- Confirm that all canoe participants wear life jackets.
- Instruct canoe participants on how to properly float with a life jacket (to be instructed at the camp pool prior to canoe experience).
- Correctly put away all equipment used during the water front activity after participants have left for the day.
