

Servant Leaders in Training (SALT) Director

Responsible to Camp Director

Qualifications:

- 18 to 99 years old.
- One year of camp experience in organized camping, preferably at Camp Wilderness Ridge, but not required.
- Must have a proven ability and desire to lead, learn, and give as a servant of Jesus Christ, to meet the needs of all campers and staff.
- Must have a written testimony of faith and trust in Jesus Christ alone for eternal life.

Responsibilities:

- Have a desire to maintain a clean and healthy camp atmosphere.
- Meet weekly with Camp Director to review SALT team and their assignments.
- Attend all staff daily prayer and devotion meetings, lifting up yourself, campers and fellow staff in prayer.
- Spend time reviewing the curriculum booklet provided by CWR so that you can be teaching SALT'ees throughout the day.
- Schedules all SALT activities for the week in coordination with the Camp Director, Summer Program Director, Food Services Director and Facilities Director.
 - To include:
 - Assistance with kitchen operations:
 - Preparation and clean-up of eating area for campers
 - Washing dishes
 - Cleaning of kitchen facility
 - Trash Clean-up
 - Assistance with food preparation
 - Assistance with serving of meals
 - Assistance with maintenance of facilities:
 - Grounds policed and kept clean daily.
 - Shower and rest room areas cleaned daily.
 - Lodge & First-Aid Station cleaned daily.
 - Trash stowed or disposed of daily.
 - Organize work projects to repair or improve camp facilities.
 - Assistance with program activities:
 - Per daily schedule provided by Summer Program Director to set up and clean up for each activity designated.
- Responsible for SALT members spiritual accountability:
 - Bible Study and devotional times.
 - To have one-to-one time with each SALT member.
 - Completes SALT evaluations at the end of each camping session.
