

What to Bring!

In order for your son to have the greatest experience at camp it's a good idea to bring the following items:

MUST HAVE

Bible

Pen

Notepad

Sleeping bag/Bedding

Pillow

Bathing suit

Plenty of socks and undergarments

Closed Toe Shoes

Flashlight

Sun screen

Bug repellent

Two Towels

Toilet articles

T-shirts

Shorts

Warm/Cool clothing (appropriate to the weather)

Water canteen

NICE TO HAVE

Extra pair of Sturdy shoes

Hiking boots

Long pants

Sun glasses

Rain jacket

Hat

Poncho

Long sleeve shirt

Camouflage clothes

Fishing pole

Backpack

Small folding pocket knife

Camera and film

Flip flops for pool

Note: Socks must be worn with shoes - NO EXCEPTIONS!

Note: If your son has diet restrictions please note on the medical form and let us know as soon as possible so we can prepare for his arrival. ALSO inform the camp nurse verbally and with a written note upon arrival. If you have any special snacks please give to the camp nurse upon arrival so they can be distributed at the appropriate time.

It is equally important that your son leave some things at home. The following items are not welcome at camp:

Radios, TV's, electronic games, comic books, cell phones, large non-folding knives, canned drinks or food.

If your son brings any of these items to camp, they will be collected and stored in the camp office until the end of the week of camp, and returned upon his departure.
